The Fund's sub-advisor believes that earnings growth drives stock performance. They also believe that mid-cap markets are inefficient and contain some of the fastest growing stocks.

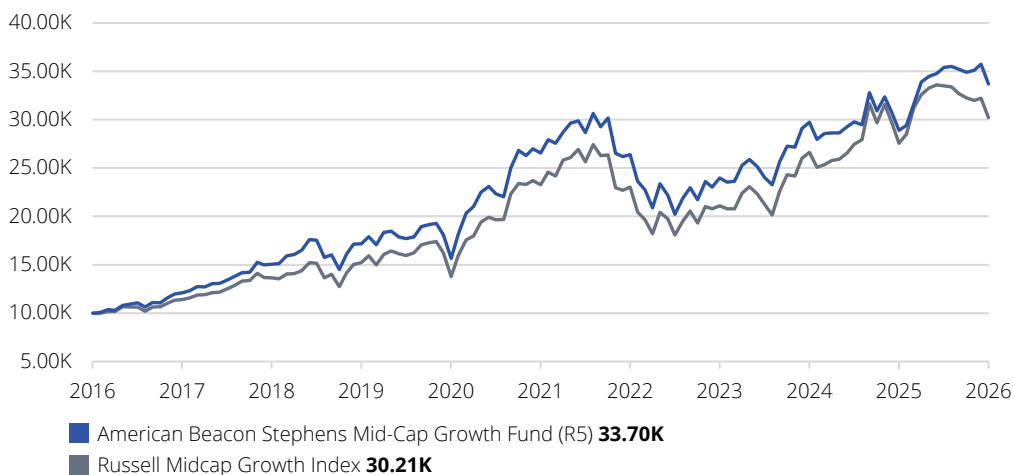
- By using behavioral finance principles to identify overconfidence and anchoring by others, the Fund seeks securities mispriced by other investors.

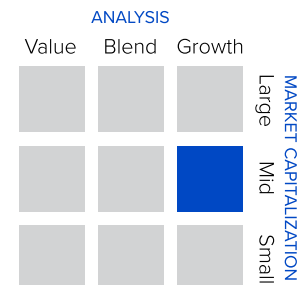

The P/E Ratio of a stock is calculated by dividing the current price by forecasted 12-month earnings

per share. The P/B Ratio of a stock is calculated by dividing the current price by book value per share. Return on Equity (ROE) is net income divided by net worth. R-squared (R2) is the percentage of the Fund's three-year return that is explained by movements in its benchmark index. Alpha is a measure of the Fund's expected performance versus the benchmark, adjusted for relative risk. Beta is a measure of the Fund's volatility versus the benchmark. Sharpe Ratio is a measure of the Fund's return per unit of total risk. Standard Deviation is a measure of the historical volatility of the Fund's returns.

The Morningstar Style Box™ reveals a fund's current investment strategy. For equity funds, the vertical axis is based on market capitalization of the Fund's holdings (large, mid and small); the horizontal axis shows growth and valuation analysis of the Fund's holdings (value, blend and growth).

For each fund with at least a three-year history, Morningstar calculates a Morningstar Rating™ based on a Morningstar Risk-Adjusted Return measure that accounts for variation in a fund's monthly performance (including the effects of sales charges, loads and redemption fees), placing more emphasis on downward variations and rewarding consistent performance. The top 10% of funds in each category receive 5 stars, the next 22.5% receive 4 stars, the next 35% receive 3 stars, the next 22.5% receive 2 stars and the bottom 10% receive 1 star. (Each share class is counted as a fraction of one fund within the scale and rated separately, which may cause slight variations in the distribution percentages.) The Overall Morningstar Rating for a fund is derived from a weighted average of performance figures associated with its three-, five- and 10-year (if applicable) Morningstar Rating metrics. In the U.S.-domiciled Mid-Cap Growth category, the American Beacon Stephens Mid-Cap Growth Fund (R5 Class) was rated 5 stars out of 469 funds overall. The fund was rated 4 stars out of 469 funds; 4 stars out of 448 funds and 5 stars out of 374 funds for the three-, five- and 10-year periods, respectively.
