SECTOR-LEVEL ATTRIBUTION (R5 CLASS)

Performance Commentary for the Quarter Ended June 30, 2026 (Attribution vs. the ICE BofA U.S. 3-Month Treasury Bill Index)

- Performance was supported by all three pillars of the Fund's strategy: income generation, volatility monetization and valuation improvement. Risk markets benefited from optimism surrounding the U.S. economy and the potential for a ceasefire in the Middle East.
- Income generation, measured by static yield (current yield plus the short-interest rebate), remained elevated amid persistent inflation and a resilient labor market. The Federal Reserve removed its outlook for interest rate cuts, which should help keep short-interest rebates elevated, while yields increased across the curve.
- The Fund's low duration profile helped it avoid the negative impact of rising rates, including higher short-term rates, as the yield curve flattened.
- Volatility monetization also contributed positively to returns, as single-stock volatility remained elevated while overall market volatility stayed subdued. Rich technology valuations and widely dispersed earnings expectations drove unusually high single-stock volatility, creating opportunities to benefit from equity hedge adjustments. At the same time, low broad-market volatility and improving investor sentiment contributed to tighter credit spreads.
- The convertible market's concentration in growth- and innovation-oriented companies continues to provide differentiated access to some of the most dynamic areas of the global economy while retaining the structural advantages of the asset class.
- The Fund generally pairs long positions in convertible bonds with actively managed short positions in common stock and call options. This approach reduces the Fund's equity beta to near zero while maintaining fixed-income exposure. Additional capital appreciation is pursued through convertible bonds moving toward fair value and active equity hedge-ratio adjustments.
